

I. GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE APPLICATIONS

- In accordance with article 41 Bis of the General Health Law, those public, social or private health care establishments that carry out research activities on human beings and that carry out research activities in human beings may request registration from the Research Ethics Committee (CEI).
 according to their degree of complexity and level of resolution (correspond to the establishments referred to in article 70 of the Regulation of the General Health Law on the Provision of Medical Care Services), are able to install and guarantee the operation of said committee.
- Applications for registration of the Research Ethics Committee will be subject to the provisions of article 41 Bis and 98 of the General Health Law, the current General Provisions issued by CONBIOÉTICA for the Integration and Functioning of the CEI. - The application for CEI registration must be presented in the current official format, signed by the director, the director or the person who acts as owner of the establishment, and presented to the National Bioethics Commission, on business days and hours, in format physical. Directed to:

Application submission options:

- 1. Sending documents by certified mail or parcel, with postage paid by the establishment.
- 2. In person, it will only be received if you have an appointment, so you must request it at 5554872760 ext. 59471 oa cei conbioetica@salud.gob.mx_____
- ÿ Submit the documentation in letter size, in the strict order established in this tutorial, it must be legible and without erasures or amendments, without crimping, stapling, without folders or dividers. No additional documentation not requested for the respective procedure will be received.
- ÿ It is important to let you know that the different **examples of formats** presented in this tutorial are intended to guide users, they can be adapted according to the needs of each establishment, including the minimum elements established in the National Guide for Integration and CEI Operation, 6th edition 2018 (GNIF-CEI). The current application format is not an example, so it should not be modified. You can access them at the following link:

- ÿ It is the responsibility of the applicant CEI to ensure that the contact information (telephone numbers and emails) entered in the registration application are correct. If they are subsequently modified, they must notify in a timely manner through the email cei.conbioetica@salud.gob.mx to the National Bioethics Commission.

2.	Simple copy of the document that certifies the legal representation of the Establishment.	 For public institutions: ÿ Appointment of the director, the director or the person who serves as the head of the establishment. ÿ If another person (other than the director, the director or the person who serves as the owner of the establishment) serves as legal representative, they must present: Creation decree or internal regulation indicating the position/position held by the legal representation and appointment of the occupant of said position. For private or social institutions and some public ones: ÿ Article of incorporation or power of attorney indicating the name of the person holding legal representation and the type of powers or attributions conferred.

In accordance with the Agreement that modifies the various provisions by which the General Provisions for the Integration and Functioning of the Research Ethics Committees are issued and the hospital units that must have them are established, in accordance with the established criteria by the National Bioethics Commission, published on October 31, 2012 (DOF 12/10/2020).

3.	 ÿ Simple copy of an operating metice that accredits it as a medical care establishment. ÿ For third parties authorized as clinical units to perform interchangeability and tests, presen performing and performing the current authorization issued by COFEPRIS. In these cases, the CEI registration will be valid as long as the authorization issued by COFEPRIS remains in force. 	 ÿ For establishments that carry out research on human beings that require authorization from the Secretary (as provided in article 14, section VIII, of the RLGSMIS), present a simple copy of the last 3 authorizations issued by the Federal Commission for the Protection against Sanitary Risks (COFEPRIS) where the establishment is designated as a Research Center for a specific protocol. Unforeseen cases will be reviewed individually, and documentation must be presented that proves their research activities in human beings and, where appropriate, with the respective authorization from the competent authority.
	ÿ For higher education institutions, the health license requirement does not apply; They may request CEI registration if they have programs academics in the health area, and in these research activities for health in human beings are carried out. This requirement will be evaluated in the manifest submitted for requirement number 4 described in this tutorial and, in the case of private institutions, the corresponding RVOE.

Simple copy of the approved Procedures Manual of the Research Ethics Committee.	 ÿ The procedures manual approved by the Research Ethics Committee must include the essential internal operating procedures, the internal operating mechanisms in the sessions, the requirements of the sessions and reviews, the criteria for the evaluation of research, the taking decision making, documentation management and archiving. For more details, review pages 12 to 31 of the GNIF-CEI. Based on the above, the essential elements that the Manual must incorporate are the following: to. Indicate the criteria for the selection, functions and obligations of the people who make up the committee and occup the following positions: the presidency, the members, including the secretary, the representatives of the affected nucleus (RNA) or the users of the health services (RPUSS), including the commitment to 80% in-person attendance. b. Incorporate policies, guidelines or guides in accordance with good clinical practices of the establishment. c. Indicate the obligations of the establishment where the CEI is installed, as well as those of the director, the director or the person who acts as the owner of the establishment. d. Describe the resources and source of financing for the operation of the CEI. and. Define the policies for the renewal, replacement or resignation of members. F. Point out the mechanisms to prevent and manage conflicts of interest. g. Outline the requirements of IEC sessions, including legal quorum and registration of the same.

	Simple copy of the professional license of each member and postgraduate degree, if applicable.	 ÿ All proposed people (even if they are foreigners) must have a professional license issued by the SEP, to be part of the CEI. ÿ The professions provided for in current regulations for CEI members are: medicine, psychology, nursing, social work, sociology, anthropology, philosophy and law.
8.	Except for the representative of the affected group or the users of health services.	ÿ Professionals from other professions may be accepted as long as they are related to the therapeutic or knowledge areas on which the applicant establishment researches, for example: biological pharmaceutical chemistry, industrial pharmaceutical chemical, nutrition, etc.
		ÿ If the members have specialty or postgraduate certificates, they must attach them, but they DO NOT replace the bachelor's degree certificates.

		no more than 10 publications.

III. IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING YOUR APPLICATION

ÿ In accordance with current regulations, only the legal representative and/or authorized person(s) indicated in fields (4) and (5) of the registration application form will be provided with information regarding the status of the request and will be authorized to collect the respective resolution at the facilities of the National Bioethics Commission.

If you had advice and/or support from the State Bioethics Commission (CEB) of your entity, you can add the contact information of the CEB as people authorized to receive notifications in field (5) of the registration application form.



Therefore, make sure to register them correctly in the section:

- ÿ When CONBIOÉTICA concludes the evaluation of the registration application, you will be informed of the availability of the resolution letter corresponding to the email addresses registered in said application, to coordinate sending it to the establishment.
- ÿ In order to guarantee the safety of the subjects participating in the research and the scientific integrity thereof, the National Bioethics Commission will reserve the right to request additional documentation or information in accordance with the current CEI General Provisions, for further reference.
